There is a place on the enclosed IRS form 8283 for the signature of the appraiser of your property. If the donated material has a value of less than five thousand dollars the form indicates that the appraisal is not needed.



If you would like Sail USA to receive your property, please complete and sign the enclosed forms and return the forms in the enclosed envelope. In order to take advantage of any tax consideration available, please sign the 8283 and return it also. We will endorse the 8283 and return it to you. Please be sure to include your social security number on the conveyance of ownership form. If you would like a representative to visit you please give us a call and we will make an appointment with you to discuss your situation.

In most cases, Sail USA will take care of transporting your property in a timely fashion. If we can not arrange such transportation, we will notify you before you make the contribution. I would like to thank you for considering Sail USA as the recipient of your contribution. I will assure you that your property will be put to good use, and we will keep in touch with you regarding its ultimate disposition.

If you plan to donate your boat, motor vehicle, or other material and you feel the value is more than \$5,000.00, the Internal Revenue Service insists that you acquire an appraisal. If the value is less than \$5,000.00 the appraisal is not required.

DONATING your power, sail boat or vehicle will be a rewarding experience because of the tax deduction and the knowledge that it will be going to good use. If you have questions regarding your own tax situation, the questions should be directed to a qualified tax consultant.

A staff person is prepared to meet with you once you have decided to choose SAIL USA as the beneficiary of your property. SAIL USA will handle all matters regarding the transfer of ownership and delivery of your property in a timely manner.
